



Q & As in a circle

The students are given five minutes to think of questions they would like to ask their friends or newcomers. For example, "how many icecreams did you eat?", "did you swim in a swimming pool?", "what's your favourite colour?". The students then form two circles, an inner circle and an outer one. The inner circle is static, faces the outer circle and answers the questions posed. The outer circle moves from peer to peer of the inner circle and poses the questions. When a full circle is completed the two circles interchange. If there are more than twelve pupils in a classroom, it is preferable that two sets of circles are formed. Finally, pupils share the information they have learnt about their peers with the whole classroom and comment.

Summer Holidays Paper Airplane

- 1. Hand out A4 sheets of paper and ask students to give a few hints relevant to their summer holidays.
- 2. Ask them to fold the paper into a paper airplane. Ask them if they know how to make one that flies really nice, and if they don't, show them how to do it.
- 3. When everyone is ready, on your count, everyone flies their planes toward the middle of the room. Have them pick up a plane that landed near them.
- 4. Students take turns reading what is written on each plane and try to guess whose it is.
